

### How long will the NRA evaluation process take?

The evaluation process is carried out in a very deliberate and thorough manner. It normally requires a minimum of 60 days from the date all required paperwork has been properly completed and received by the Training Counselor Program Coordinator. After it is completed, you will be notified of the status of your appointment.

**The final evaluation is based on the following NRA Training Counselor appointment criteria:**

- ◆ TC application (including teaching, leadership, firearms and shooting experience).
- ◆ Community service (e.g., youth organizations, 4-H, PTA, civic clubs).
- ◆ NRA Certified Instructor's experience and activity with basic course reports submitted (five courses and at least 25 properly certified students).
- ◆ Attendance and performance at an NRA Training Counselor Workshop (evaluation/recommendation from the workshop staff).
- ◆ References (three letters of reference submitted at workshop).
- ◆ NRA's need for training counselors in the area.
- ◆ Payment of appropriate fees.

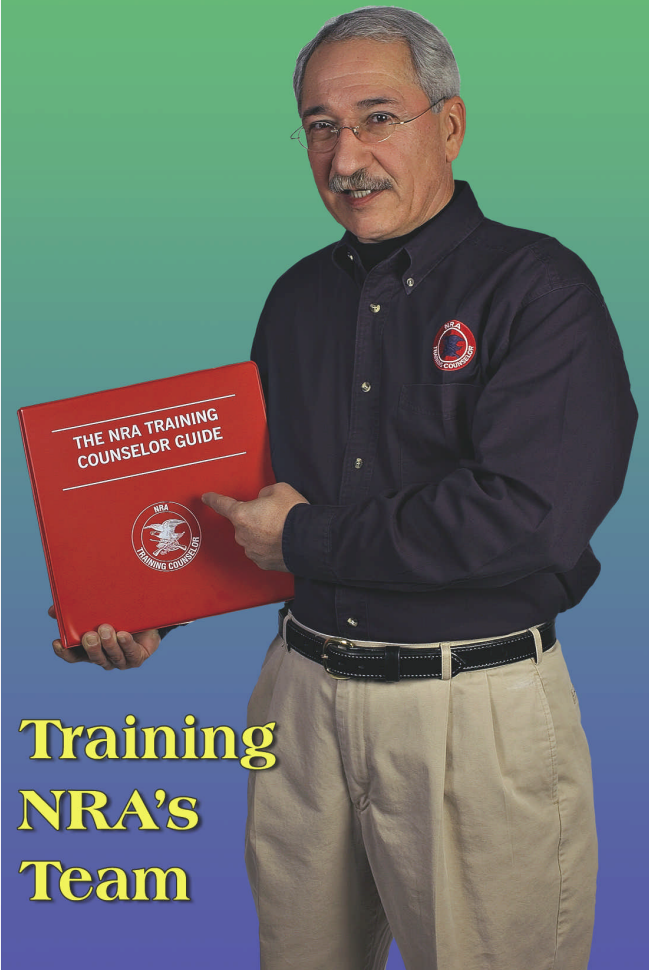
